Introduction:

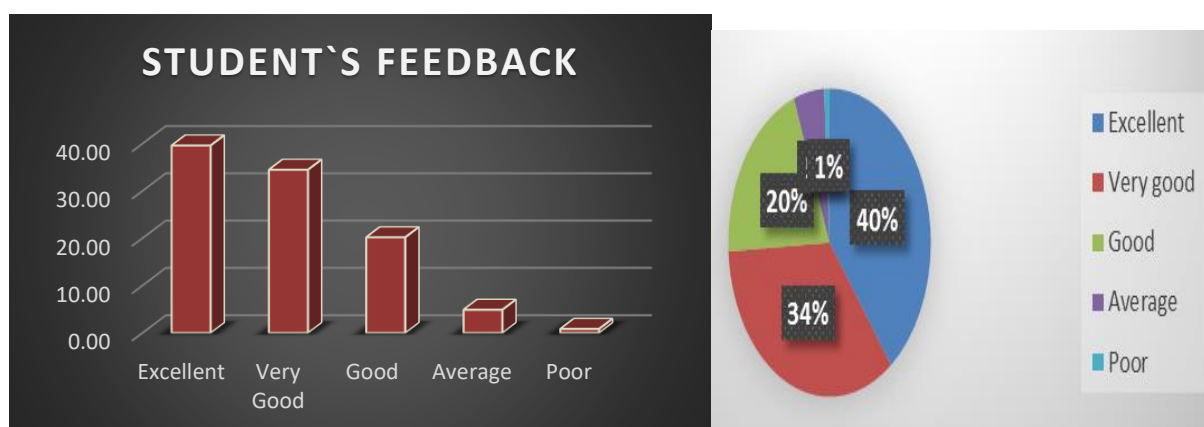

- Students highly appreciated the academic related facilities such as library, laboratories, playground and administrative help.

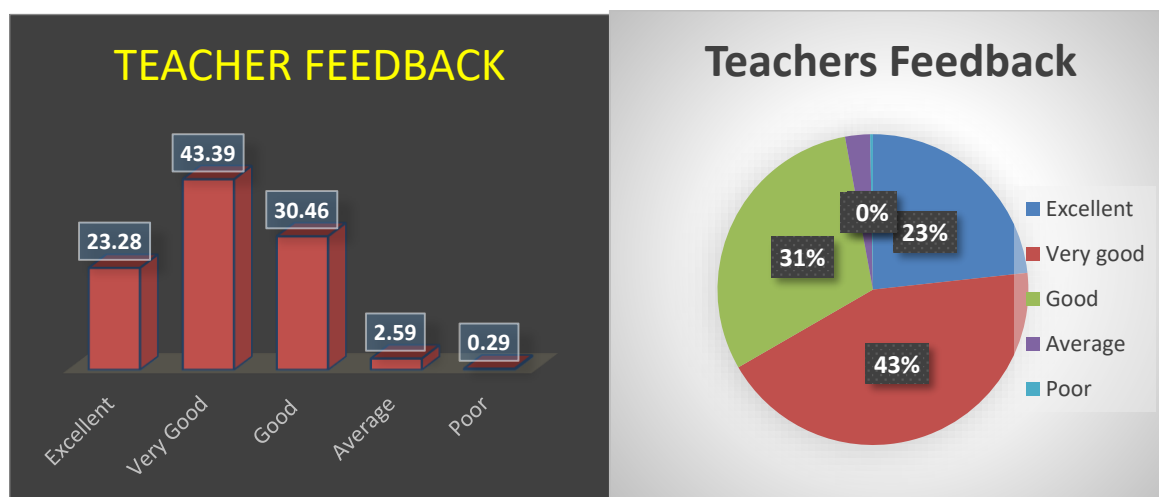
- It is observed from the students feedback that there is need for improvements in the ICT facilities.

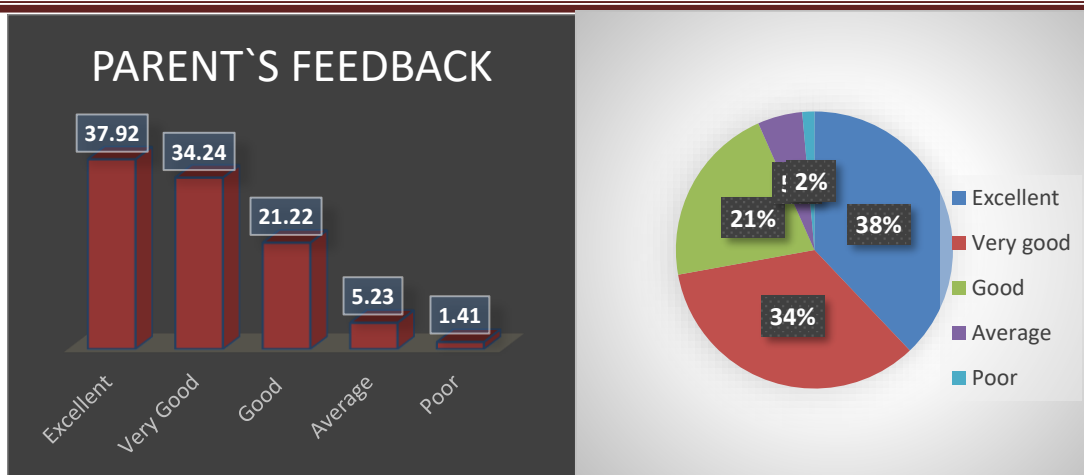

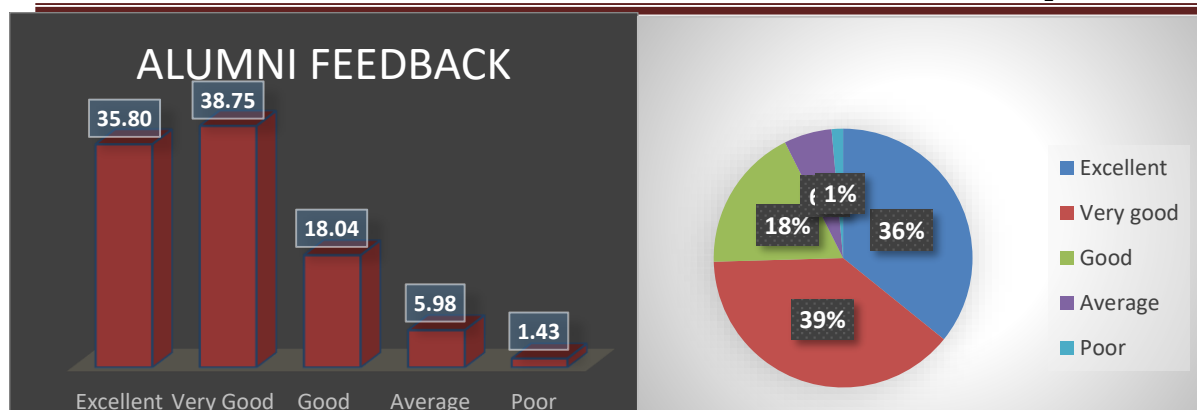
