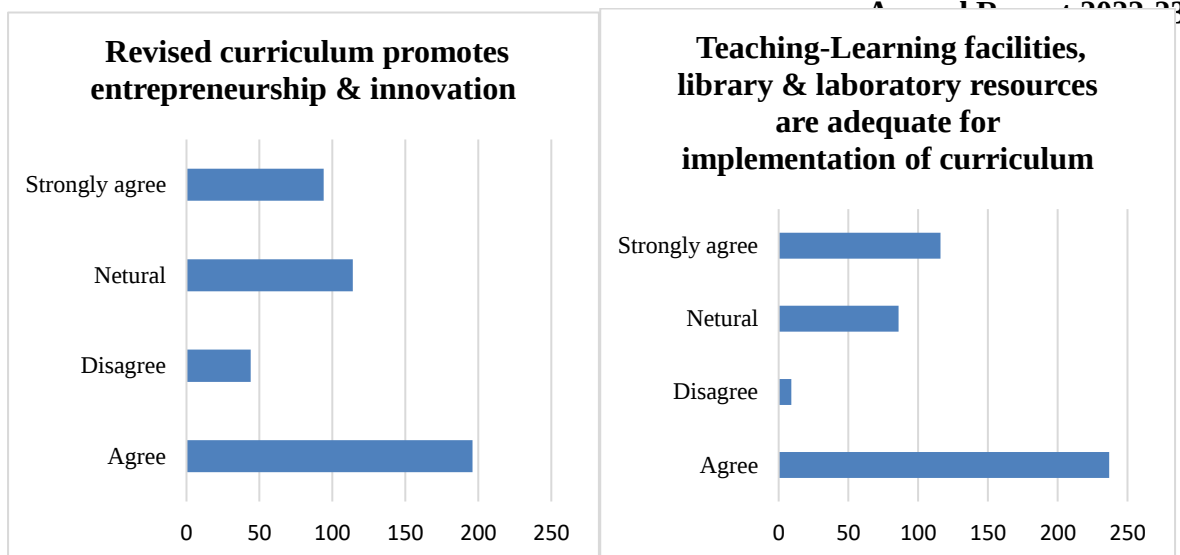
Student Feedback:

The analysis of each topic is given in the following chart:





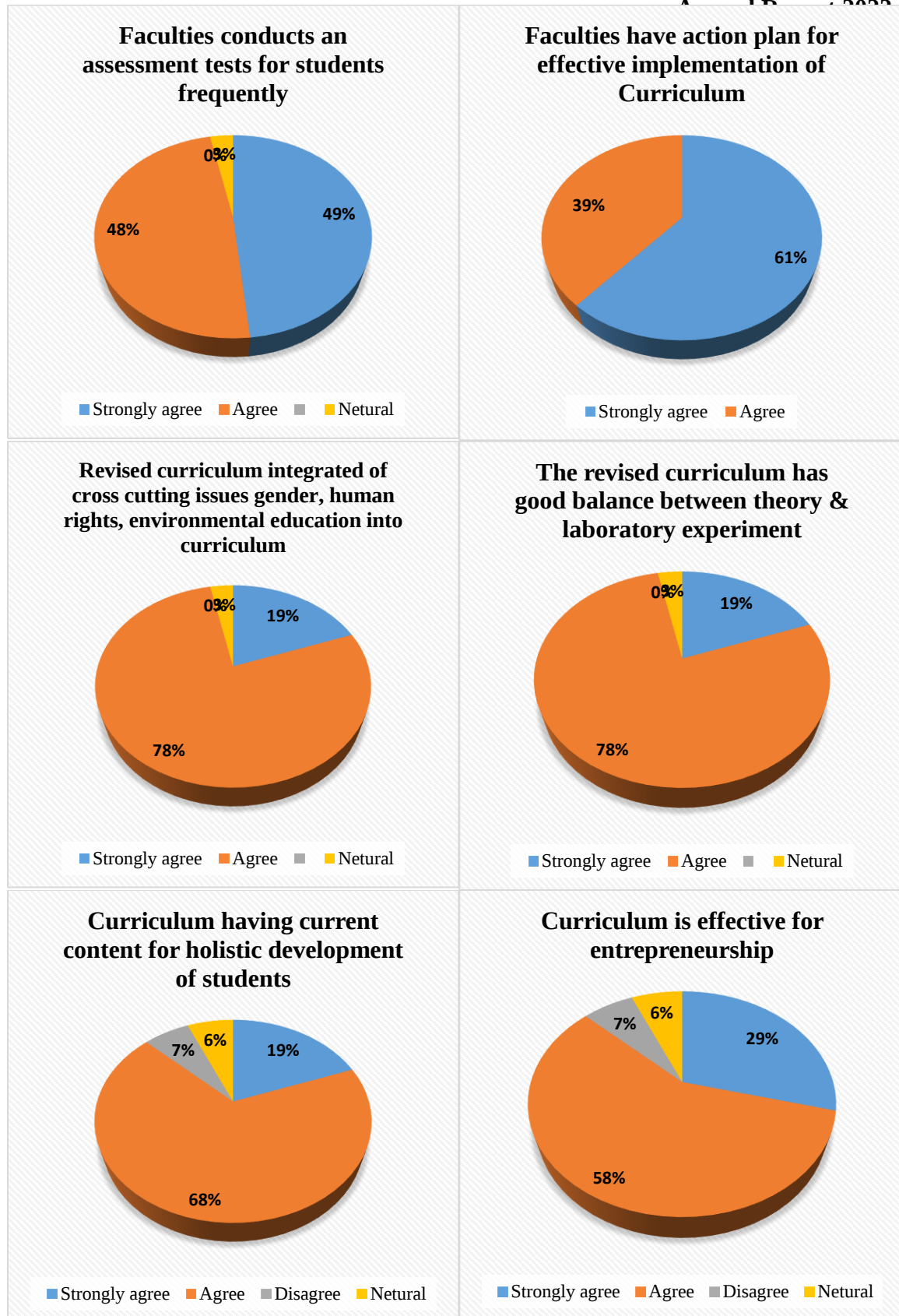

- 26% students strongly agreed and 58% agreed that the revised curriculum has enhanced employability.
- 69% students agree and 24% strongly agree that the revised curriculum is economically, socially & environmentally useful.
- Students felt that revised curriculum promotes entrepreneurship & innovation, enhanced employability and helpful in personality development of students.
- Total 67 % students from all students feel that revised curriculum is appropriately designed for the current needs.
- 26% students strongly agree and 53% students agree that teaching-learning facilities, library & laboratory resources are adequate for implementation of effective curriculum.

Teacher feedback:

The institute is affiliated to the 'Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune', therefore, institute follows prescribed curriculum developed by Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. Teachers inculcate this curriculum values among the students very effectively. Online feedback on curriculum is taken by the respective subject teacher targeting suggestions and improvement about the revised curriculum. 31 online feedback have been received about the curriculum by the teachers.

Based on the analysis, following conclusions were drawn:

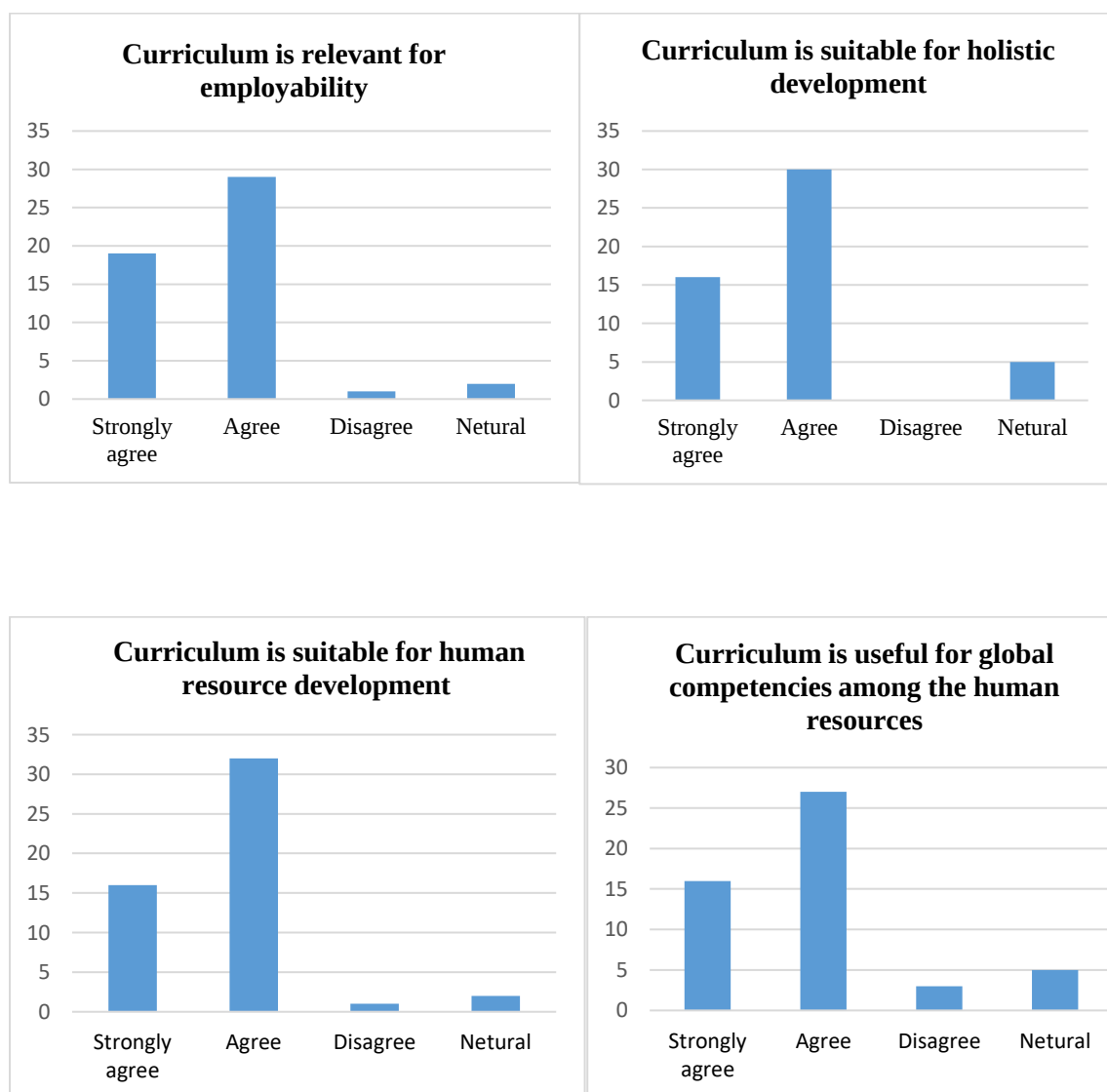
- Most of the teachers are satisfied with the curriculum designed by Savitribai Phule Pune University.
- 68% teachers agreed that revised curriculum having current content for holistic development of students.

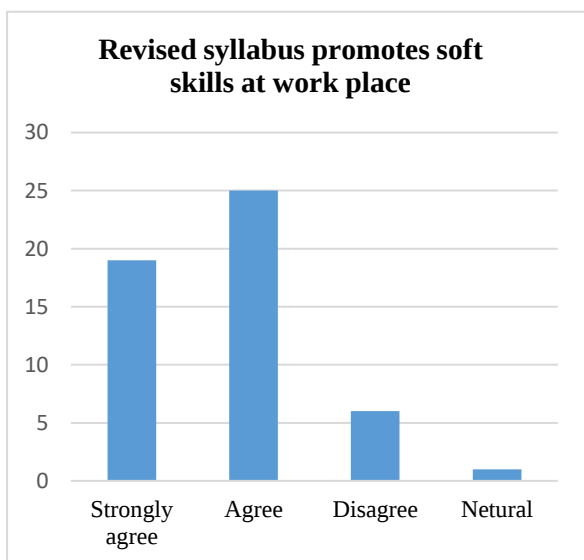
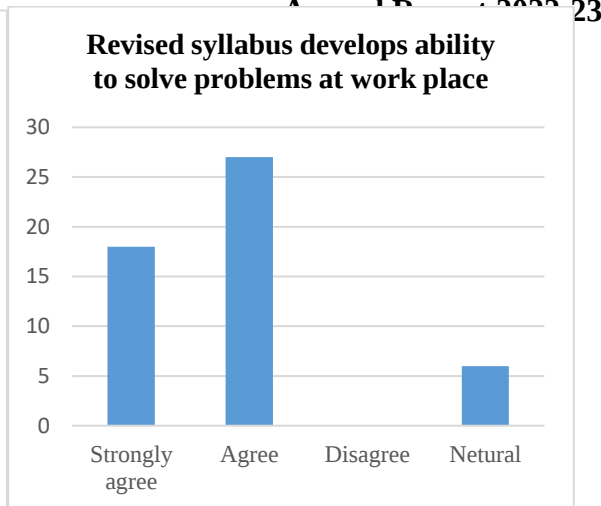
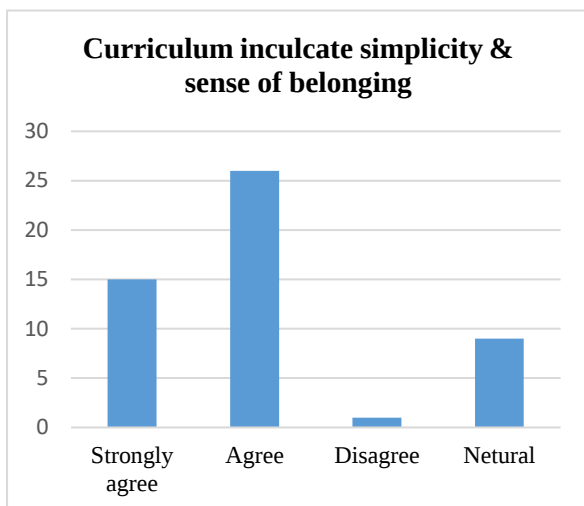
• 78% teachers agreed and 19% teachers strongly agreed that the revised curriculum have integration of cross cutting issues gender, human rights, and environmental education.

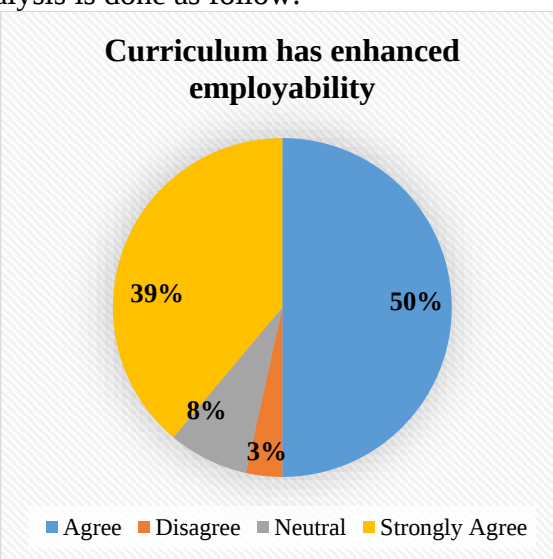
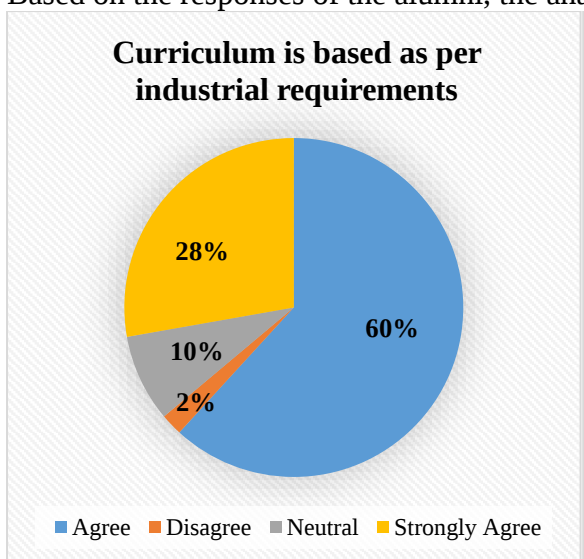

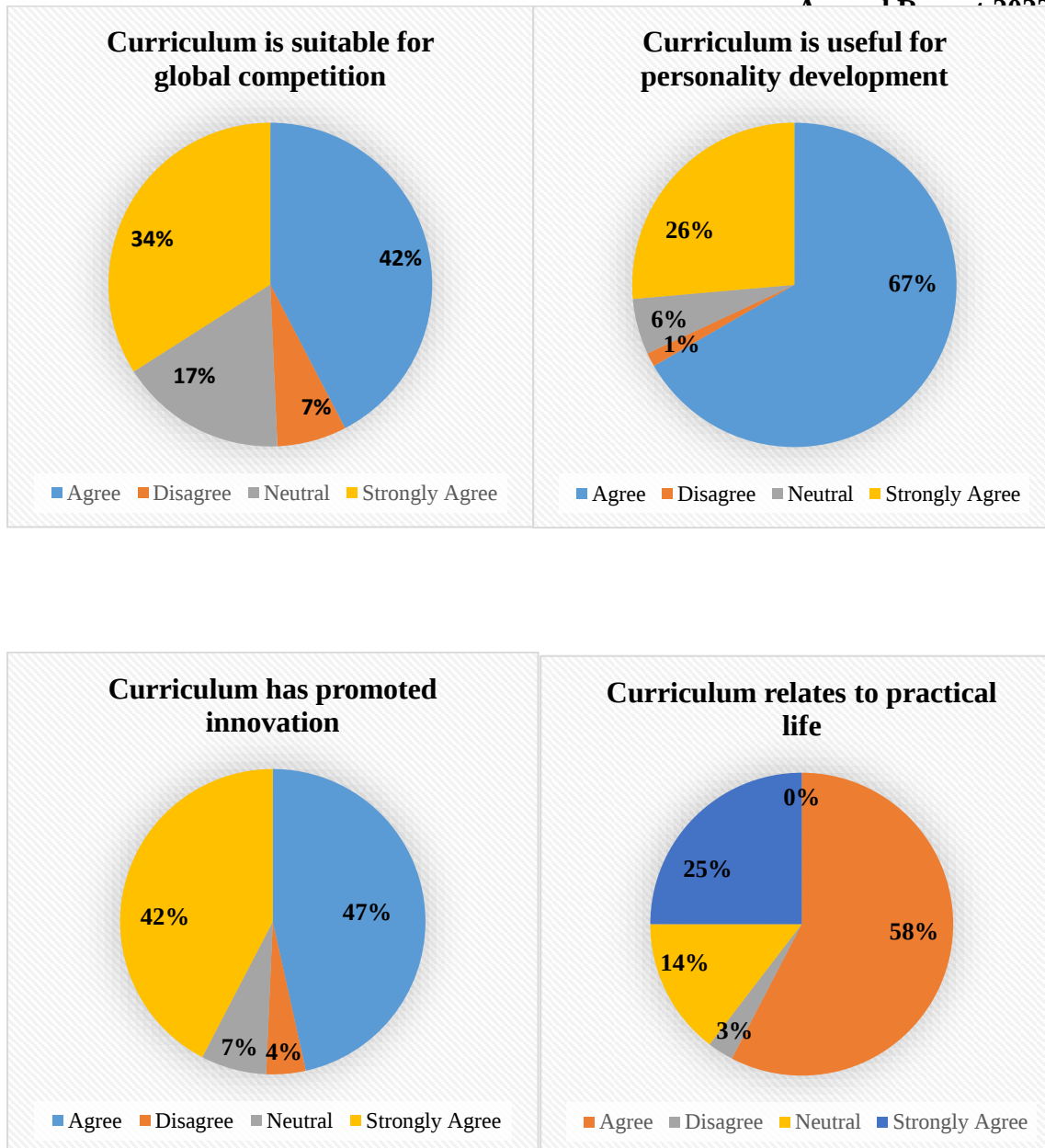
Alumni Feedback:

Based on the responses of the alumni, the analysis is done as follow:





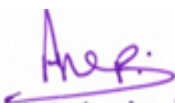
Based on the analysis of alumni feedback, following conclusions were drawn:
