CODE OF ETHICS FOR RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Every true research has a moral and social value. As per the norms of the research related activities, there are some legal rules. The ethical concepts and principles are important to criticize, evaluate, propose, or interpret laws. The 'ethics' focuses on the **disciplines that study** standards of conduct, such as Science, Philosophy, Theology, Psychology, or Sociology. There are norms of **method, procedure, or perspective** for deciding how to act and for analyzing complex problems and issues. Hence an Institution has urge to researchers to avoid disobedience in the research outcomes, research report writings and publication of research papers.

For knowledge, truth, and avoidance of error, cooperation and coordination among many different people in different disciplines and institutions, ethical standards promote the **values that are essential to collaborative work**, such as trust, accountability, mutual respect, and fairness.

It has been found that, there are many activities as "misconduct" in the field of research such as-

1. Publishing the same paper in two different journals without telling the editors.
2. Including a colleague as an author on a paper in return for a favor even though the colleague did not make a serious contribution to the paper.
3. Discussing with your colleagues confidential data from a paper that you are reviewing for a journal.
4. Using data, ideas, or methods you learn about while reviewing a grant or a papers without permission.
5. Copying a data set without discussing your reasons in paper.
6. Using an inappropriate statistical technique in order to enhance the significance of your research.

7. Publications without passing the peer review process and announcing your results through a press conference without giving peers adequate information to review your work.
8. Conducting a review of the literature that fails to acknowledge the contributions of other people in the field or relevant prior work.
9. Giving the same research project to graduate or post graduate students in order to see who can do it the fastest.
10. Failing to keep good research records.
11. Failing to maintain research data for a reasonable period of time.
12. Making significant deviations from the research protocol approved by your institution's Animal Care in animal science Research without telling the Institution/University or the board.
13. Wasting animals in research.
14. Exposing students and staff to biological risks in violation of your institution's bio-safety rules.
15. Stealing supplies, books, or data.
16. Making unauthorized copies of data, papers, or computer programs.

Research ethics provides the guidelines for responsible conduct of research. It educates and monitors scientists conducting research to ensure a high ethical standard.

As per all these misconducts in the field of research, the Research committee and IQAC of the college has come to the conclusion that, every faculty or researcher in his/her research work, such as doing M. Phil; Ph.D; Major/Minor research projects, and or research paper publications will be subject to the following rules,

1. **Honesty:** Honestly report data, results, methods and procedures, and publication status.
Do not fabricate, falsify, or misrepresent data.

2. **Objectivity:** Strive to avoid bias in experimental design, data analysis, data interpretation, peer review, personnel decisions, grant writing, expert testimony, and other aspects of research.
3. **Integrity:** Keep your promises and agreements sincerely; always try for consistency of thought and action.
4. **Carefulness:** Carefully and critically examine your own work, avoid careless errors and negligence; Keep good records of research activities.
5. **Openness:** Share data, results, ideas, tools, resources. Be open to criticism or discussion and new ideas.
6. **Respect for Intellectual Property:** Honor patents, copyrights, and other forms of intellectual property. Do not use unpublished data, methods, or results without permission. Give credit where credit is due. Never plagiarize.
7. **Confidentiality:** Protect confidential communications, such as papers or grants submitted for publication, personnel records, trade or military secrets, and patient records.
8. **Responsible Publication:** Publish in order to advance research and scholarship, not to advance just your own career. Avoid wasteful and duplicative publication.
9. **Responsible Mentoring:** Help to educate, mentor, and advise students. Promote their welfare and allow them to make their own decisions.
10. **Respect for Colleagues:** Respect your colleagues and treat them fairly.
11. **Social Responsibility:** Strive to promote social good and prevent or mitigate social harms through research, public education, and advocacy.
12. **Non-Discrimination:** Avoid discrimination against colleagues or students on the basis of sex, race, ethnicity, or other factors that are not related to their scientific competence and integrity.

13. **Competence:** Maintain and improve your own professional competence and expertise through lifelong education and learning; take steps to promote competence in science as a whole.
14. **Legality:** Know and obey relevant laws and institutional and governmental policies.
15. **Animal Care:** Show proper respect and care for animals when using them in research. Do not conduct unnecessary or poorly designed animal experiments.
16. **Plagiarism-** check the research data by the agency of plagiarism before to publish.
17. **UGC approved Journal-** Be publish your research article in UGC approved journals.
18. **Duty of research guide/researcher-** Plagiarism by students, professors, or researchers is considered academic dishonesty or academic fraud, and offenders are subject to academic censure, up to and including expulsion. Use of plagiarism detection software to uncover potential plagiarism and to deter students from plagiarizing is common. So be alert during research report writing and publications.
